Greetings sisters and brothers! Love and Peace to you all.

May is Child Month and this year our church is celebrating Child Month under the theme **"Reignited by the Spirit to Love and Protect Our Children"**.

This Child Month we want to make our children feel extra special, loved, and protected. In keeping with the Ministry of Education Daily Tips, here are some methods to do so.

1. Remember to say "I love you" to your child/ward daily.
2. Encourage your child/ward to say "no" in situations where they feel uncomfortable.
3. Educate your child/ward on the importance of setting boundaries.
4. Children need affection. Give your child/ward a hug.
5. Teach your children that it is okay to confide in you.
6. Spend quality family time with your children.
7. Attend church with your child/ward.
8. Together, prepare a list of persons to contact in case of an emergency.
9. Give your child/ward hugs frequently.
10. Teach Children to value and respect their teachers.

Let us embrace the day two (2) 2023 Synodical Bible Study which encouraged us to "Reconnect Our Relationship with Our Children" under the following: -

- Recognise and teach your children that they have value and are a part of the Kingdom of God. Matthew 18:4-Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

- Include your children in the regular worship experience, not only Children's and Girls'/Boys' Brigade Sundays. Matthew 19:13-15- Then little children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and pray, but the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven."
- Guide your children to God. Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Sisters and brothers, as we reconnect and reinforce our love and protection for our children, our parents and church school teachers will be paying tribute to them.

Our children will also be given an opportunity to make a difference in our church with their talents and gifts from God.

Prayers by Church School Leaders and Children

On each Sunday starting May 14th, one Church School superintendent or teacher will pray for our nation's children and each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, three (3) children will say a prayer, a Bible verse or do an item. The prayers will end on June 9th. This should be done by audio recording and sent to the Commission at least two (2) work days before the release. This will be circulated throughout the United Church. Each week will be done by a Region as follows:

Week 3 - NERMC	May 28, 29, 31 & June 1
Week 4 - CIRMC	June 4, 5, 7 & 9

Please include in the recordings the name and age of the child and the name of the church school.
